Reliable Agency Scholarship (One scholarship, \$1000)

- Business major
- Maintain an overall 3.0 GPA
- 2nd year student
- Must be full-time (minimum 12 credits)

LaMarche Creek Scholarship (Two scholarships, \$2,500 each) (\$1,250 for fall semester, \$1,250 for spring semester to two students)

- First Year student as of Fall 2016
- First generation college student (parents/grandparents did **not** attend college)
- Established (permanent) resident of Carlton County or Southern St. Louis County
- High unmet financial need
- Essay of your background; how this scholarship will help you attain educational goals.

Friends of the Foundation Scholarship (Five scholarships, \$500 each)

- First-year student
- Must be registered for minimum of 9 credits
- 3.0 GPA or above
- Financial need

The scholarship program is to encourage the enrollment and success of students in higher education. The scholarship program is intended to provide financial support and recognition of students who have demonstrated qualities of academic success and leadership within Fond du Lac Tribal and Community College (FDLTCC).

The Scholarships will be awarded once per semester unless specified otherwise stated by certain scholarship guidelines. The FDLTCC Foundation scholarships are made possible by contributions from private donors, businesses, foundation sponsors, and fundraisers. The Foundation is a non-profit organization and is run by a Board of Directors made up of community, alumni, and staff/faculty members.

You must be registered as a FDLTCC student and enrolled in number of credits listed on each specific scholarship. Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 (unless otherwise listed on specific scholarship criteria) from FDLTCC, a current higher education school if a transfer student, or from a high school if you are a new student.

Some scholarships have specific eligibility criteria, such as Tribal enrollee or specific study program. Please review eligibility criteria of each scholarship.
