

## Accuplacer Current Schedule

The Accuplacer test is **required** for all new students **unless** the student:

- Completed the Accuplacer assessment testing previously (within the past three years for Reading and within the past two years for Math). The documentation of scores must be provided to FDLTCC, or
- Completed college English and/or Math courses; an official copy of your transcript must be provided to FDLTCC, or
- Completed the ACT within the past five years for Reading, English, and Math and have a minimum score of Reading-21, English- 18, Math- 22. You must provide an official ACT reports to FDLTCC.
- Have reached college level benchmark scores on MCA (Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments) 10 grade MCA reading- 1047 (not English classes) 11 grade MCA math- 1158 College Algebra, 1148 Introduction to Statistics
- Completed the SAT within the past five years for Reading, English, and Math and have a minimum score of 480 Reading, 480 Writing, 530 Math (College Algebra)
- You must provide an official SAT report to FDLTCC.

In order to take the Accuplacer the student **should**:

- Fill out a Fond du Lac Tribal and Community College application for admission  
**\*Application should be turned in at least one week prior to taking test\***
- Have Social Security number or FDLTCC student ID available
- Have Picture ID available
- Prepare for the Accuplacer by reviewing the practice test at <https://accuplacer.collegeboard.org/students>

The Accuplacer will take approximately (2) hours. Please plan to arrive 10-15 minutes early. This test is free of charge and you do not need to schedule an appointment to take it. In most cases, Accuplacer is not a pass or fail test, it is simply a placement tool used to ensure you are placed in the appropriate level math, writing, and reading classes.
