1. Complete 60 required semester credits numbered 1000 or above with a minimum grade point average of 2.0.
2. Complete at least 20 semester credits at FDLTCC, including the last 12 semester credits.
3. Complete with a passing grade AMIN 1050 Anishinaabeg of Lake Superior.
4. Complete at least 24 semester credits of general education selected from at least six of the ten goal areas of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum.
5. Complete at least 20 semester credits taught by the faculty recommending the award.
