Minimum Qualifications:

- **American Indian Studies** - Bachelor's degree with a major in Native American Studies or with 20 semester/30 quarter credits in courses which support the development of expertise in the assigned field.
- **Biology** - Master's degree with a major in biology; or master's degree in any discipline/field with a minimum of 18 semester/24 quarter graduate credits in biology.
- **Elementary Education** - *Education Requirement:* Bachelor degree in education with 12 semester credits in early childhood education. *Occupational Experience Requirement:* Four full-time (or equivalent) years of verified related paid work experience with children ages birth to eight years old. One year of this work experience shall be within the five years immediately preceding the date of application for the credential field. The recency requirement shall be waived if the individual has two years of successful full-time (or equivalent) postsecondary teaching experience in the credential field within the last five years.
- **English** - Master's degree with a major in English; or a Master's degree with a minimum of 18 semester/27 quarter graduate credits in English.
- **History** - Master's degree with a major in history; or a Master's degree with a minimum of 18 semester/27 quarter graduate credits in history.
- **Math** - Master's degree with a major in mathematics/ or a Master's degree with a minimum of 18 semester/27 quarter graduate credits in mathematics.
- **Political Science** - Master's degree with a major in political science; or Master's degree in any discipline/field with a minimum of 18 semester/27 quarter graduate credits in political science.
- **Philosophy** - Master's degree with a major in philosophy; or Master's degree in any discipline/field with a minimum of 18 semester/27 quarter graduate credits in philosophy.
- **Sociology** - Master's degree with a major in sociology; or a Master's degree with a minimum of 18 semester/27 quarter graduate credits in sociology.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Teaching experience in post-secondary setting.
- Ability to work with culturally diverse student populations having a broad range of interest and skills.
