- 1. Complete 60 required semester credits numbered 1000 or above with a minimum grade point average of 2.0.
- 2. Complete at least 20 semester credits at FDLTCC, including the last 12 semester credits.
- 3. Complete with a passing grade AMIN 1050 Anishinaabeg of Lake Superior.
- 4. Complete at least 24 semester credits of general education selected from at least six of the ten goal areas of the 'Minnesota Transfer Curriculum.
- 5. Complete at least 20 semester credits taught by the faculty recommending the award.

Students should use this program plan as a guide when selecting courses to complete a degree in a major.
