The Chemical Dependency Counselor Certificate meets the course content educational requirements for the Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselor (LADC) application in Minnesota.

The State of Minnesota requirements for the LADC are a bachelor's degree from an accredited school or educational program with 18 semester credits in approved Chemical Dependency Counselor preparatory course work plus 880 hours of academic Internship (Practicum) in a setting which satisfies MN Statute 148C.04 plus a written exam (ICRC exam).
