The Geography Foundations Certificate is designed to provide focus to an Associate of Arts Degree or another program of study around spatial thinking and geographic knowledge. Geography is a broad, interdisciplinary field that includes many employable skills, such as research, map reading and creation, place-based knowledge, earth systems science, cultural sensitivity, theoretical approaches to race, class, and gender, and understandings of spatial processes. Certificate coursework may transfer toward a major or minor in Geography at the Bachelor's level.
