














## Students by Underrepresented Status






## 2<sup>nd</sup> Fall Retention (Full-time and Part-time) by Student of Color


## 2<sup>nd</sup> Fall Retention (Full-time and Part-time) by American Indian Race/Ethnicity


## 2<sup>nd</sup> Fall Retention (Full-time and Part-time) by Black Race/Ethnicity

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Fall Retention (Full-time and Part-time) by Pell Eligible



## 2<sup>nd</sup> Fall Retention (Full-time and Part-time) by Underrepresented Status







## 4<sup>th</sup> Fall Graduation Rate by American Indian Race/Ethnicity




## 4<sup>th</sup> Fall Graduation Rate by Black Race/Ethnicity



## 4<sup>th</sup> Fall Graduation Rate by First Generation College






## $4^{\rm th}$ Fall Graduation Rate by Pell Eligibility










## 4<sup>th</sup> Fall Graduation Rate by Traditional (<25yr) and Non-Traditional Age (25≥yr)

- Compare our performance against the performance of 2-year college peers

The College utilizes the Educational Testing Service (ETS) to conduct this student learning exit exam. The College compares itself to over 100 other associate degree conferring institutions. The comparison population is over 90,000 students.




### Nilie PACE Report Survey




