Her latest book is *Duluth: Zenith City & Beyond*.

Peggy is the author of two full-length poetry collections and five chapbooks. Her newest release, *PA*, won second place in the 2022 Wisconsin Fellowship of Poets Chapbook Contest and Honorable Mention in the 2022 Northeast Minnesota Book Awards.
