



2020-2021 Academic Year Report High School Nandagikendan (Seek to Learn) Academy Report

Due to COVID, a majority of Seek to Learn events were conducted virtually. There were three sections of the Academy due to varying circumstances at the Fond du Lac Ojibwe School and the Cloquet High School. Virtual events for both schools were held starting in October and ending on April 6th. Two in-person events were scheduled for Cloquet High School, who were having some in-person classes for students. These were held April 15th (8 participants) and April 20th (4 participants). The Fond du Lac Ojibwe School wanted additional virtual events to end the school year, as they were still having classes online. Four events were held: April 26th (20 participants), May 4th (21 participants), May 5th (22 participants), and May 6th (25 participants). Throughout the 2020-2021 Academic Year, 44 students participated at least once in the Seek to Learn Academy (though many were repeats) and 146 students to college/university connections were made.
