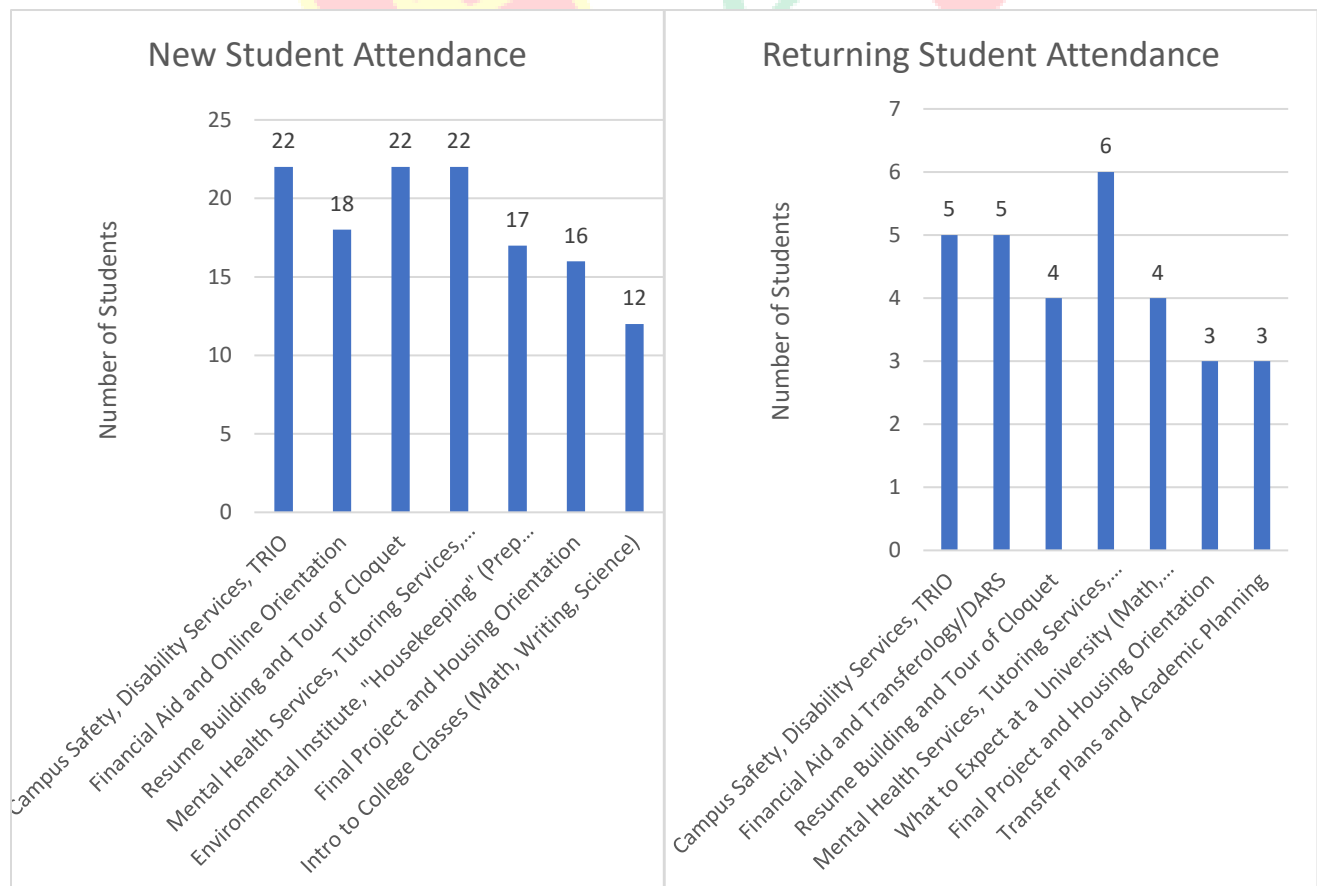




2022 Dorm Student Nandagikendan (Seek to Learn) Academy
