Figure 1: New Student Attendance of events during the Academy.





Figure 2: Returning Student Attendance of events during the Academy.








Figure 3: Percentage of Students that Answered "Yes" to Pre-Survey Questions. 19 students had completed the pre-survey.






Figure 4: Percentage of New Students that Answered "Yes" to Post-Survey Questions. Though 13 students completed the post-survey, the average attendance of events was 18 students.






Figure 5: Percentage of Returning Students that Answered "Yes" to Pre-Survey Questions. Five students completed the Pre-Survey and received the Academy schedule.






Figure 6: Percentage of Returning Students that Answered "Yes" to Post-Survey Questions. Three students completed the Post-Survey while the average attendance was four students.














Short Survey from August 17th
