Eligibility Criteria:

- Scholarship available to 2025 high school graduates attending Fond du Lac Tribal and Community College Fall Semester 2025
- Graduating from a high school within the counties of:
 - Carlton County, MN
 - St. Louis County, MN
 - Pine County, MN
 - Aitkin County, MN
 - Douglas County, WI
- Minimum High School GPA of 2.5
 - Provide an official high school transcript after high school graduation to the FDLTCC Admissions office before scholarship deadline
- Enrolled in classes by July 15th at FDLTCC for Fall Semester as a full-time student (12 or more credits).
- Student must maintain satisfactory academic progress (2.0 or above GPA and 67% completion rate) for spring semester award. Student must be enrolled as a full-time student (12 or more credits) for spring semester for spring scholarship award.

- Completed Scholarship Application form (reverse side)
- Scholarship Essay (see guidelines below)

Essay Requirements:

- 8.5" x 11" page: 1" inch margins all around; 12-point font; double-spaced
- 150-300 words; typed
 - What interests you in attending Fond du Lac Tribal and Community College?
 - What are your goals for the future?
 - List extracurricular/volunteer efforts you have been involved in (community/school/church etc.)
