Scholarships available to Education students:

Please review the scholarship and requirements for each of the scholarships listed below. Most of the scholarships require a paragraph of why you would like to be apply to the FDLTCC elementary education program.

- **Minnesota Indian Teacher Training Program (MITTP FY 22) Scholarship (For IMMEDIATE release):**
 - This application is for the Spring Semester of 2022 and summer 2022 semesters (if you are taking courses towards your degree). Please apply ASAP.
- Requirements: An eligible student is a person who:
 - has origins in any of the original peoples of North America and maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition; and



- Is:
 - A student, including a teacher aide employed by a district receiving a joint grant or their contracted partner institutions, who intends to become a teacher or is interested in the field of education, and enrolled in a postsecondary institution; and working towards their MN Licensure and
 - A student who, after applying for federal and state financial aid and an Indian scholarship according to Minnesota Statutes, section 136.126, has financial needs that remain unmet.
- Financial need must be determined according to the congressional methodology for needs determination or as otherwise set in federal law.
